

End of Year 12 Exams

End of year exams will take place in the week beginning 29th June 2020.

Obviously we can't follow the usual format of establishing exam conditions at school so I'm setting up a virtual exam week. Please read the following instructions carefully.

AM exams will begin at 9.30 am, PM exams will begin at 1.00 pm

1. Please set yourself up to be able to work without distractions as best you can.
2. Turn phones onto airplane mode and use your timers set for the duration of the exam.
3. I will email your exam to you around 10 minutes before your start time.
4. Please complete your answers either in word or on a paper pad – there's no need to print the exam paper out.
5. Clearly label the number of the question that your answer is for.
6. Return the answer document or photos of your written answers to me by email within 10 minutes of the end of the exam.

There are two exceptions:

- Art - Miss Evans will be in touch with instructions.
- English - Ms Pitt will set the exams via MS Teams.

Please try and make this as realistic an experience for yourselves as possible and set yourself up to prepare for and sit each exam as if it's an actual public exam next May / June. Staff need to be able to use your responses to diagnose where you're going with your work and how to help you put it right. This is even more crucial given the circumstances this year.

It goes without saying that unless stated otherwise, every exam is closed book including no internet access.
